

Jesus Changes Water Into Wine

V.1, On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus’ mother was there, **V.2**, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. **V.3**, When the wine was gone, Jesus’ mother said to him, “They have no more wine.” **V.4**, “Woman, why do you involve me?” Jesus replied. “My hour has not yet come.” **V.5**, His mother said to the servants, “Do whatever he tells you.” **V.6**, Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. **V.7**, Jesus said to the servants, “Fill the jars with water”; so they filled them to the brim. **V.8**, Then he told them, “Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet .” They did so, **V.9**, and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside **V.10**, and said, “Everyone brings out choice wine first then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now.” **V.11**, What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him. **V.12**, After this he went down to Capernaum with his mother and brothers and his disciples.

*This lesson of God’s grace to us tells me that Jesus has come really to do things for us that we can only dream about. John is teaching us about God’s goodness and Grace. Every story he tells us is not something Jesus did just once and never again, but of something which he is ever doing for us. John tells us not of things that Jesus once did when he was here on earth, but of things that he still does today. John wants us to see here, is not that Jesus once upon a day turned some water pots of water into wine; he wants us to see that whenever Jesus comes into a man or woman’s life, there comes a new quality which is **like turning water into wine**. Without Jesus, life is dull and stale and flat; When Jesus comes into our life it becomes brand new, sparkling and exciting. Without Jesus, life is drab and uninteresting, with him it is thrilling and exhilarating. This story is John saying to us: **“If you want the new exhilaration, become a follower of Jesus Christ, and there will come a change in your life which will be like water turning into wine!!!** (This could be our testimony)*
