1 John 2:28-3:10

v.27. As for you, the anointing you, receive from Him remains in you....and that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in Him. v.28, And now, dear children, continue in Him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before Him at His coming. v. 29, If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who does what is right has been born of Him. 3: 1—10:v.1 See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know Him. v.2, Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know when Christ appears, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as he is. All who have this hope in Him purify themselves, just as He is pure. V.4, Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact sin is lawlessness. v.5, But you know that He appeared so that He might take away our sins. And in Him is no sin.v.6, No one who lives in Him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen Him or known Him. v.7, Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. The one who does what is right is righteous, just as He is righteous. v.8, The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work. v.9, No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God. v.10 This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are; Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister.

Praying the Word, FOR OUR CHILDREN: Father, I pray and believe according to Your Word that our children will be victorious over the wicked one, and they will come to know You and be aware of You, more than ever before. I pray that they will be strong and vigorous in the Word and it will always abide in their hearts so they will be victorious over the wicked one. I pray they will NOT love or cherish the world or the things that are in the world, or have the lust of the flesh (craving for sensual gratification) or the lust of the eyes (greedy longings of the mind) or the pride of life (assurance in their own resources or in the stability of earthly things) I pray that they will do Your will and carry out Your purposes in their lives and they will remain in it forever. I also pray they will confess and acknowledge Your Son, Jesus everyday with their mouths (and with their attitudes in life), and they will keep in their hearts what they have heard from the beginning about You, and if what they have heard from the first will dwell and remain in them, they will dwell in the Son and You always. I pray that they will abide in You and remain permanently in Him so that when He is made visible they may have and enjoy perfect confidence (boldness, assurance) and not be ashamed and shrink from Him at His coming. I pray that they will remain in communion with and in obedience to Him. Let no one deceive them or lead them astray, (least of all by their own self). I pray they will practice righteousness, and live a consistently conscientious life, and be righteous even as He is righteous. Father, we know the reason the Son of God was made manifest was to undo (destroy, loosen, and dissolve) the works of the devil, so I pray that Your nature will abide in them. Your principle of life, Your divine sperm, will remain permanently in them so they cannot practice sinning because they are born and begotten of YOU. In Jesus name!!!
